Summary: (machine translated)

Dam with water drainage directly at the entry (risk low); during our ascent very clean water; beautiful limestone; 1-2 slides; very short canyon; worthwhile in combination with other canyons in the area or ideal beginner's tour, very well equipped; is often commercially walked; exposure S.

Access: (machine translated)

approx. 40min

From Belluno on the SS51 direction Longarone. Before Longarone follow the signs for Pordenone. Cross the bridge over the Piave river. After the bridge turn left towards Erto, Claut (SR 251). Go up the mountain road past Erto until you reach Claut. At the end of Claut (after the soccer field and the bar "K2") you cross the bridge over the Chiadola. After that there is a large parking lot on the right (+ nice picnic area near the streambed).

Approach: (machine translated)

About 10min

From the parking lot you go down to the picnic area. Here you can already see the wooden signs with the canyoning inscription. Follow the path on the orographic left side of the creek and then climb up to the houses and the already visible bridge. Here, right at the bridge (small climbing garden), climb up again briefly until you are in front of the dam. Entry at about 660m.

Tour: (machine translated)

about 50min

The Chiadola is a very short but worthwhile lime canyon that is perfectly arranged. Without a long way, the total of seven rappelling points follow each other shortly up to a maximum of 20m. If the water depth allows it, some places can be slid. Below the bridge is the last and highest rappel point (20m with shower...). The belaystation is on the right side and can be reached safely via a fixed rope traverse. If you want to bypass this point, you can get off before the bridge on the left. After this abseil point you will reach the access path shortly. Exit at about 600m.

At the man-made step, step left out of the creek and follow the access path back to the picnic area/parking lot shortly.
