Coming on the B 308 follow the signposted path to Winkel to the parking lot "Starzlachklamm".

Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking lot, it takes about 15 minutes to reach the entrance to the Klammsteig on a well-maintained hiking trail. Here you can buy an entrance ticket (2007: 2,50 x) and continue along the path through the canyon until the path forks at the exit. Turn right over the wooden bridge and continue for about 100 m until you reach a bench on the orographic left side of the stream.

Tour: (machine translated)

At the first waterfall it is not necessary to rappel through the water, even if it looks very unpleasant from below. When there is a lot of water, the narrow channel in the middle section may become tricky and you will have problems reaching the belay hook at the top left. The small waterfall below forms a siphon with the stone above, from which it is possible to jump after checking the underwater.\nThe final waterfall is approached in the narrow chute on the right. For the long final slide, one places one's backside on the left side of the swim gully rim exactly on a somewhat protruding nose, in order to get into the banked bend in the best possible way. Even then, however, the slide is not controllable, the impact is usually broadside directly on the edge of the gorge below the rock, but landing on the rock and sliding into the water is also no problem.\nThe gorge has the status of a natural monument and may not be entered before May 15 because of the breeding season of the dipper. The gorge is also used for commercial purposes.

Return: (machine translated)

After the last waterfall below the ticket booth, turn right up to the trail we came in on.
