Alpine rappel canyon where running sections alternate with vertical parts. Lots of downclimbing.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From Bolzano about 35 km on the A22 south, then exit to Mezzocorona and from there north to P2 (parking exit) at the houses of Maso Nuovo (see map in photo gallery). \nWith the second car we then go to the valley station of the cable car "Funivia Monte"(see implementation in photo gallery). Also well doable on foot.

Approach: (machine translated)

The cable car (one way 5 euros - 2014) brings us quickly to 890m altitude. We take the path "500", then "507" in the direction of Malga Kraun. It joins a forest road that we follow. Soon we cross the Val Piaget. We follow the path for about 60 minutes in total. Then we come to a side stream of Val Fredda. We can either enter already via this one or go a little further to enter directly into the main stream (see overview sketches in photo gallery).

Tour: (machine translated)

10 rappel; First some from trees, the valley is still relatively open. Then the canyon narrows and we come to the key point, the 130m waterfall - "Cascatina Batol". First 10m to the edge, then 30m with belaying offset to the left on a sloping rock band, then the remaining 90m.\nContinue in a rock chaos with some smaller rappels and rappels. Finally, another high fall (10m + 65m) before arriving on the flat.

At the house turn left and follow the road around parking lot P2.

Great rappel canyon with impressive wall height. The two high rappels are beautiful. Otherwise a lot of walking, but varied. Important: Take a small plate and nut with you as well as a wrench or pliers. Anchors keep coming loose because of the limestone. The upper anchors in the 140 meter step could be replaced. Also be careful with falling rocks! (machine translated)
