Summary: (machine translated) Sequence of rappels and downclimbs, up to the c90 highlight.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Nice, head north into the Tineetal valley on the D 2205 to Isola. At the traffic circle, take the second exit and take the first turning on the left. Park before or after the bridge over the Tinée.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the car, follow the path to the right over the tinée. After approx. 150m, a path goes uphill on the left-hand side. Do NOT turn off at approx. 970m, but continue uphill on the path until you reach a gravel road. Follow the track to the right until the road crosses the stream (approx. 1110 m).		
Tour: (machine translated) Sequence of rappels and downclimbs, up to the c90 highlight. Be careful, the rock is very slippery. The canyon is very incised and there are no emergency exits.		
Return: (machine translated) Before the confluence with the Tinée, get out on the right and follow the car on the gravel road to the bridge //.
