#### **Access:** (machine translated)

The road from Illertal via Rohrmoos is closed to motor traffic. So you take, from the B 19 at Fischen (between Sonthofen and Oberstdorf)turning right the district road OA 9 in the direction of Obermaiselstein. Passing this village, you go over the Riedbergpass (approx. 1400 m above sea level) down to Balderschwang. A little later you pass the border to Austria. About 5,5 km after the border you turn left to Sibratsgfäll. You pass the village and continue straight on, always in about the same direction and altitude. At a former landslide the tar surface is missing in sections. About 3 km after Sibratsgfäll you come to a road widening with a small (equipment, formerly customs) house, on the left a wooden well trough. Park your car here (960 m above sea level). You can also drive through the Bregenz Forest via Hittisau to Sibratsgfäll.

## **Approach:** (machine translated)

Go back on the road for about 100 m (in the direction of Sibratsgfäll), then take the dirt road that turns off at a sharp angle and go up on the right (if necessary, open a barbed wire and close it again). After overcoming 70 meters of altitude, you meet a tarred road, which you follow to the right and subsequently cross two small streams. Now the road describes a long left-hand bend and touches another brook. Cross this stream on a dirt road that branches off to the right at the exit of the left bend. You can now either follow this side stream of the Fugenbach orographic left in southeastern direction down to the Fugenbach (pathless) or follow the dirt road for a few hundred meters until footprints on the right lead down to the Fugenbach (partly through swampy terrain).

## **Tour:** (machine translated)

Border river between the municipalities of Sibratsgfäll, district of Bregenz in the Austrian state of Vorarlberg and Balderschwang in the Bavarian-Swabian district of Oberallgäu, at the same time\nBorder between Bregenz Forest and the Allgäu Alps. Short but varied tour in an attractive environment, without difficulties, also suitable for beginners and generally recommended.\nAfter canyoning is generally prohibited in Germany, kept you on the orographic. right - Austrian - side! (joke.)

#### **Return:** (machine translated)

Where the gulch emerges from the gulch still a few meters downstream and then on relatively clear footprints left up to the road and on this left over the bridge to the car (15 min.).
