Summary: (machine translated)

Alpine rappel canyon, south-facing. It has 2 parts of different character. The upper one largely open, repeated with runs between the rappels, the lower one narrowly cut. Relatively much deadwood in both parts.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

The starting point is the village of Griesen in the Loisach Valley on the Garmisch-Partenkirchen - Ehrwald/Lermoos connecting road. The village is located about 1200m northeast of the German-Austrian border. Parking is possible on both sides of the bridge.

Approach: (machine translated)

We start east of the bridge over the Neidernach, which flows into the Loisach a few meters below. We take the forest road on the orographic left bank of the Neidernach and hike upstream, past a field chapel. We cross the Nudelgraben and the Sunkenlaine. 1000m after the beginning of the trail and 140m after crossing the Sunkenlaine we turn right (signpost "Schellschlicht"). We follow the path, which later becomes a path, uphill. At 950 m above sea level the path branches. On the left (signpost "Schellalm"-251") in a few meters you reach the footbridge over the Schellaine. Here is the lower access. To do this, from the next leftward hairpin bend of the path, we cross somewhat precariously over the gorge drop into the streambed. If we want to do the integral ascent, we take the right branch ("252") upward at the fork of the path. First in serpentines upwards we then cross the slope above the Schellaine in a northerly direction, and then again in serpentines to about 1320m a.s.l.. Here we can cross to the left into a side cirque of the Schellaine, where the descent starts. It is worthwhile, however, to climb a little further here and then cross at about the same altitude into the next cirque to start the descent there in the stream.

Tour: (machine translated)

First some rappel, then also running sections, before the rappel again more. At the narrows again and again blocked deadwood. At 1010m a.s.l. right exit possibility before the 2nd part. In the more attractive, because narrow cut, 2nd part, smaller rappels alternate with phases of rappelling, until you are finally down in the open streambed.

Return: (machine translated)

Follow the streambed to the forest road and return on it to the parking lot.
