A lot of walking and climbing down, a few steps, which can also be slid or jumped.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Coming from Ajaccio we head for Porto. Before the bridge over the Rivière de Porto we stay right on the D84 direction Evisa. After 6.1 km (from the bridge) we turn left on the D124 in the direction of Ota. 2.1 km further on we cross a bridge and park our car a few meters further on for the exit. With the second car we drive back to the D84 and then turn left in the direction of Evisa. 6.3 km uphill, then we come to a road junction, where the D24 leaves the D84 in the direction of Marignana. At this fork (IGN "579") we park the car for the access.

Approach: (machine translated)

Now we are looking for a track that descends steeply in the NE direction to the creek. We should reach it a few meters above the C25.

Tour: (machine translated)

Right at the beginning the C25 with handrail. Then another rappel (C12), the "rest" is walking and downclimbing, interspersed with some jumps and slides. At the Ponte de Zaglia the tour is over.

Return: (machine translated)

We exit to the left onto the long-distance path "Tra Mare et Monti" and walk through the lower Spelunca canyon towards Ota. This brings us to the bridge where our car is parked for the exit.
