### Hydrology:

#### Access: (machine translated)

From Breil-sur-Roya take the N204 up the Roya valley for approx. 18 km to Tende. In the center of this small town, turn right towards the campsite. Opposite the entrance to the campsite (C. Municipal - marker "58"), continue straight ahead along the narrow road on the right, which later becomes a dirt road. After entering the Vallon de Réfrei, pass marker "306" (lac de Pia) and keep left towards Castel Tournou until you reach marker "318". Park your car here.

## Approach: (machine translated)

Now continue on foot and uphill towards Refrei and Castel Tournou (yellow markers). A path that branches off to the left at a cairn later crosses "our" stream above the last higher rappel. However, we continue straight on uphill here. After about 1 hour you reach a saddle with a small white wayside shrine and shortly before that a dark rock passage. Above it is a rock face with embrasures. Here we take the path to the left - a little indistinct at first - and after a good 10 minutes we turn left at a suitable point down to the streambed. It makes no difference whether we descend 5 minutes after the turn-off or 15 minutes later.

## Tour: (machine translated)

12 rappels, initially longer, later shorter ones. The ambience is particularly interesting, even during access.

#### Return: (machine translated)

Either by crossing a path that leads to the farmstead on the right, or descend via a longer and further small rappel until the path from the farmstead crosses again (from here the 15 minutes are counted). If you choose the first exit option, do not walk to the farmstead, but descend discreetly along the right edge of the canyon until you reach the path that leads down from the farmstead.
