<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) This is the lower part of the long stream that flows through the valley of the same name, a large water catchment area fed by the glaciers on the north face of the Tessa peak. The stream rises at an altitude of three thousand meters and its riverbed is quite open and wide. It is very impressive how wide the streambed is in the part just before the entry point and how it suddenly narrows after a few meters. This feature should give us pause for thought about the devastating power of spring floods		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Parking exit approach: from Bolzano, head towards Merano and then continue into Val Venosta, turning off into Val Senales shortly after the village of Naturno. About 1 kilometer before the turn-off to Kartause/ Certosa, you will see the turn-off to Val di Fosse- Pfossental on the right-hand side. If you have two cars, you can park the first vehicle shortly after the turn-off, near the bridge over the Schnalser Bach stream. Parking entry: with the second car, drive about 500 meters further to the first bend at the Tumlhof, WHERE you can ask if you can park the car.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Access: From the Tumlhof farm, follow the unpaved path past the farm on the left until you reach the streambed on the right-hand side. If you follow the course of the river, you will pass an old mill and immediately find the first abseiling point after 50 meters.		
<b>Tour:</b>		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Exit: after the last jump (about 2 meters). at the mouth of the Schnalser Bach, climb back up on the right side of the river.
