Top of 3 canyoning accessible and spatially separated parts. Short, but fierce in terms of water flow in the narrow canyon.

We leave the A8 coming from Bern at Interlaken via exit 25 - Wilderswil. We drive south, through Wilderswil and up to Saxeten. We drive through the village up the valley, pass a hamlet with a bus stop and park our car 750m further on, after the bridge over the stream from the Renggraben, in the parking area on the right. From here on, further travel by motor vehicle is no longer permitted.

Approach: (machine translated)

We continue along the road and after 350m we come to a place where a road branches off to the right. We follow it, after the long right turn we take the hiking trail up to the left and at the top we meet the road again. It brings us immediately to a farm. Here we now walk about 100m along the path to the east, directly towards the streambed. Shortly before reaching the streambed, take the grassed dirt road to the left and follow it for about 150m until you reach the bank of the Saxetbach (entry).

Tour: (machine translated)

After a few meters in the open streambed, the canyon begins. Already the second waterfall (C20) can be unpleasant even with average water flow in midsummer, because rappel in the stream can not be avoided. A C15, a C30 and finally a C18 follow. Then the descent is already over and we leave the streambed to the left onto the road.

Return: (machine translated)

The approach back to the car.
