Summary: (machine translated) Aquatic and dangerous canyon		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Domodossola northwards via Crodo to Baceno, there turn right on the N 659 to Premia (total approx. 20 km from Domodossola). In the village take the 2nd road on the right towards Crego. After about 150 m (after an S-loop of the road) turn left off the road onto a small road that descends towards the canyon. Where a path branches off to the right in front of the houses, park one vehicle. Back with the second vehicle and continue descending in a southerly direction on the road from Premia to Crego. At a natural climbing wall on the right, turn right and descend along the little road, later along the Toce river, to Uriezzo. Park at the chapel.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the car at Premia, descend along the aforementioned footpath to the bridge over the Toce. There, on the orographic right bank, follow a path upstream until you reach the place where the Toce river rushes down from its wide gravel and scree bed into the constriction of grown rock. Access here, possibly with a jump.		
Tour: (machine translated) The canyon is open and friendly at the beginning, but sometimes seems almost threatening in its narrows due to the strong water flow. The first narrow section after the bridge can be bypassed right above, the entry into the second constriction should definitely be bypassed right above and after the drop from the tree into the canyon ropes (17 m). If the slide that now follows after the clamping block in the water (siphon) is not passable due to obstacles (tree, stone), then on the tape left front anchor (very smooth access!). At the big waterfall, which is rappelled down on the left, cross as far as possible to the right on the foundation at the bottom of the pool below, because of the danger of backflow, before you start swimming. For the rappel in pools, a longer rope (or rope extension) is useful. There are several dams with automatic sluice opening above the canyon. Therefore, all sides (especially A.I.C.) are strongly advised against an ascent.		
Return: (machine translated) Exit about 500 m after the road bridge that connects Premia and Credo (right up to the road and on it right to Uriezzo and the car). The regular descent continues until a bridge where you get off and walk up to Uriezzo.
