<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) The upper Giessenbach is a rappel canyon with walking passages, the Hintere Giessenbachklamm is a short pedestrian gorge below the forest road.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) On the Inntal freeway A 93 direction Kiefersfelden/Kufstein. Exit Kiefersfelden, after a good 1.2 km turn left at the T-junction (direction town center and Kufstein) and after 450 m on Rosenheimer Straße turn right at the next traffic light into Thierseestraße. Now drive 3.1 kilometers (from the traffic lights) - narrow-gauge tracks alternately accompany the road - until a road branches off to the right up to Breitenau. Here we go up to the right, past the farmhouses on the left, the tarred road becomes a slope, on the left below lies the Schopperalm, we pass the fork in the road, (2.7 km from the start of the ascent - junction Thierseestraße -). At the fork in the road we see yellow signposts ("Rechenau" or "Hintere Gießenbachklamm"). Here we park the car for the entry into the middle Gießenbachklamm. However, we continue, following the signs "Hintere Gießenbachklamm 40 min". After a total of 4.4 km from Thierseestraße, we come to the hikers' parking lot at the exit of the - up to here permitted - forest road.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Continue on foot on the forest road along the Gießenbach stream. After about 500 m we see the short (only a good 100 m long) Hintere Gießenbachklamm on the right below the road. After 800 m (from the parking lot) the Alpbach flows into the Gießenbach from the left, we continue along the Gießenbach and after almost 2 km we arrive at the Naturfreundehaus Gießenbachhütte. We continue straight ahead for about 100m, then the forest road ends in a somewhat confusing fork in several paths. \nHere we have climbed at the time on the right on the steep slope above the Giessenbach.\n\nOn various topo maps, however, is also a path drawn (not verified), which after crossing the Giessenbach on the opposite orographic. right slope moves up to 1200m altitude, then moves approximately horizontally in a basically westerly direction, to after crossing the 3. Bachlaufs (according to map) right to lead down into the gravel bed of the upper Gießenbach (entry at 1140 m altitude).\n\nWeiter now but on our access at the time on the north slope above the Gießenbach leads us the at times also somewhat exposed hunters path also up to about 1200 m altitude. At about the point where the path emerges from the sparse forest onto the meadows above, we take a track that runs horizontally along the slope and then descend on sight into the wide gravel bed of the Giessenbach. We enter the stream at the same point as the access from the opposite side.		

**Tour:** (machine translated)

First we walk in the wide streambed almost horizontally, until the first slope. At the time (2006) there was a herd of ibexes in the gravel bed, which was not impressed by our coming and climbed only about 10m up the slope to let us pass.\n\nEs now follow running sections, passages of rappel and a few rappel. The last one is the highest with about (estimated from memory) 30 - 35 m. \n\nAfter that you walk about 500m downstream and then climb - here the access variant crosses the stream - left out onto the forest path on which we marched.

**Return:** (machine translated)

Passing the Naturfreundehaus we return, if we feel like it we quickly climb through the Hintere Gießenbachklamm, then follow the forest road again to the parking lot.
