Summary: (machine translated) Short attractive rappel canyon with fun potential		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From the A 13 freeway in the direction of Chur, at the height of Sargans, turn onto the A 3 in the direction of Zurich. Drive past Lake Walen to the southeastern foothills of Lake Zurich and 51.7 km after Sargans you will reach the Lachen exit (No. 41). Here we leave the A 3 and drive in first direction OSO to Siebnen and from there in southern direction over the Sattellegg mountain pass (1190 m above sea level) to the Sihlsee. On the eastern shore southwards to Euthal. From here in (eastern) direction Lattbach to Obereuthal. Park your car at the "Besenbeiz".		
Approach: (machine translated) Continue on the little road, which is now closed to motor traffic, until after approx. 500 m on the right a bridge leads over the Chrummfluebach. Beyond, the path leads uphill on the orographic left slope of the Chrummfluebach, which crosses the Chilentobel here. After about 45 minutes (from Besenbeiz) you reach a steel footbridge at a slide brake. Here you rope down into the brook.		
Tour: (machine translated) In the first part quite open canyon; after entering the attractive narrow part can practically always jump or slide. However, it is sometimes inevitable that the first rappel and determine where to jump (!). Also suitable for beginners.		
Return: (machine translated) After the exit of the gulch, still before the bridge r. out. After the tour I recommend the breaded "Plätzli" (in German: Schnitzel) in the Besenbeiz (I get no commission !).

There is one place on the left side of the canyon with 2 to 3 glue-in anchors (they look like this: https://www.climbingtechnology.com/en/professional-en/metal_anchors/fixed/glue-in_anchor_hcr), which are connected with rusty and half-broken wires. These cut my finger. I hope someone can retrieve these old wires in the future. Another bolt is in better condition on the right side, so try to avoid the glue-in anchors on the left side with broken wires. I didn't take any photos of it. (right and left follow the downstream direction) It is a lovely, well-curved canyon, short, and with less pressure on time.
