Take the A-7 north from Genoa in the direction of Milan. Exit at Ronco Scrivia and continue north on the country road towards Serravalle. About 4 km after the exit, the road passes through a hamlet called Creverina. Just before the village on the left, a narrow road leads under the railroad to the stream. Here, at the top of the road, park the lower car in a suitable place.\nContinue with the second car through Creverina and after the last houses, on the left, in front of an old distillery, a very narrow driveway turns off steeply at right angles from the main road. Continue up this road and then straight on at all the forks until the road makes a sharp right turn uphill. A dirt road branches off to the left. Park the upper vehicle here.

Approach: (machine translated)

The slope leads us, at first high above the stream, to the entry at a dam with water drainage.

Tour: (machine translated)

The short, narrow, meandering conglomerate gorge in the middle section with some jumps and a 10 m Tobbogan compensates for the previously rather boring march through shallow streambed with some tree overclimbing.\nLast rappel: here sling at the top of the tree.\nClean, but relatively cold water.

Return: (machine translated)

About 100 meters after a last abseil into a slightly larger lake, a path on the left bank leads to the railroad underpass, where the second vehicle was parked.
