**Summary:** (machine translated)

Narrow cut watery rappel canyon, side tributary to Saklikent canyon.

### Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

First, head for the canyon exit of the Saklikent canyon. If you want to walk the upper and lower parts of the monster canyon combined, park the car here for the exit.\nFrom here now (if necessary with the second car) drive the road in northern direction. After 2.7 km turn right and drive uphill towards Arsaköy. After 6.1 km uphill we meet a road coming from the north and continue on it to the right in a southerly direction. After another 3.6 km we leave the road to Arkasöy and turn half-right (GPS: 36°30'24.75 "N 29°26'25.56 "E). We follow this road in southwestern direction. After about 1.8 km we come to a T-junction (GPS: 36°29'43.72 "N 29°25'47.79 "E) and turn right here. After 100 m the road turns to the left, 270 m further on the road makes a left turn - straight ahead a side road leads, on the righthand side an elongated hall - and 570 m further on (GPS: 36°29'19.59 "N 29°25'56.43 "E - covered bus shelter) we turn half-right. We now continue another 570 m slightly downhill. Here - GPS: 36°29'7.36 "N 29°25'59.65 "E - we turn left at a right angle onto a dirt road. After 620 m the track crosses "our" brook, the Bozu. We now continue above the stream in a southwesterly direction. After 440 m (from the bridge) we stay right at a fork (near the stream). Again 820 m further on we see a well on the left side of the path. Here (GPS: 36°28'46.59 "N 29°25'42.35 "E) we park our car.

### **Approach:** (machine translated)

On sight we keep - first slightly left , then in a wide right turn - towards the streambed. We come to a shallow widening of the streambed, where no slope needs to be downclimbed (entry - GPS: 36°28'46.36 "N 29°25'35.92"E).

# **Tour:** (machine translated)

We quickly arrive at the gorge and the first rappel of a total of 12. The water is milky murky, especially at the beginning, and so every potential jump and rappel (about 6 each) must be checked for suitability. The stream winds along between smooth walls. After about 35 min. (from the start) a side stream enters from the right, almost doubling the water flow.\nAbout 100 min. after our start in the stream we came to a clearly recognizable (trail track) exit possibility out to the right.\nAbout 10 min. further in the stream we see a wooden footbridge above.\nAt the end of the first part the canyon widens, trees grow in the gravel bed. Here we find the exit up to the left after the first part - GPS: 36°28'16.60 "N 29°24'52.67 "E.

### Return: (machine translated)

At first pathless up the wide cirque we soon come across a clear track and a gate. Then we can look down into the Saklikent canyon from a saddle on the other side. At the top we find a dirt road, which we leave at the edge of a row of trees to the left onto a smaller dirt road, in order to get to the well and the car.
