Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful, open, not too long lime canyon; several walking and climbing passages; 50m final waterfall (can be bypassed on the left via emergency exit); beautiful pools with emerald green water; good standing places.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) approx. 15min From Tolmezzo take the SS52 road in the direction of Carnia --> after a long straight stretch there is a freeway bridge --> before the bridge turn left into a small side road --> here left along the road --> under the bridge to the next bridge which you cross (exit Torrente Favarinis) --> park immediately on the right (gravel parking place) approx. 260Hm.		
Approach: (machine translated) approx. 40-45min From the parking lot take the hiking trail (415) on the right for about 25min steeply up to a ruin with a wooden bench at about 480m (see map). Follow the trail for a very short time until you reach a tree with blue and red markings. Here you leave the main trail and follow the marked path on the left for another 15min (becomes increasingly steeper) to the entry at about 400m.		
Tour: (machine translated) 2h Arrived in the streambed we start immediately with the first rappel C16 (r/li) (chain anchor) in shallow pools --> jump or slide in deep pools --> short walking passages --> C28 (r.) (chain anchor) or li. bypass, stand with sling (but rope is needed) --> canyon gets a bit narrower --> short walk, downclimb or jump passage into narrow canyon section (very nice) --> after the big boulder in the middle of the canyon and the 5 rocks lined up, the canyon makes a right turn --> straight on and over a short climbing spot to the next 15m step (this can also be downclimbed on the left) --> walking and climbing --> narrow canyon section to a cut abseil spot 16m chain anchor right/left (danger of swinging left!) --> canyon opens and makes a bend to the right to a beautiful abseil (chain anchor left behind the rock), from the top right you can set up a rope traverse to the exposed chain anchor, then C25 in deep bends alternatively R30 top right --> short walking and climbing passage --> short swim before the 50m final waterfall (!!! sharp edge) which ends in a large but shallow pool (here is the possibility to take the emergency exit left before) --> the canyon exit can be downclimbed without problems --> last jump 1m in swimming pools.		
Return: (machine translated) approx. 5min Follow the mostly dry streambed for about 50m and then get off to the left before the bridge --> follow the small path to the parking lot.
