#### **Access:** (machine translated)

Coming from Bad Tölz we drive on the B13, past Lenggries, in the direction of Sylvensteinspeicher. Directly after the commercial area and 3.1 km after the exit into the center of Lenggries, we turn left from the B13 and drive to the village of Jachenau (15.5 km from B 13). We park the car in the large parking lot at the Schützenhaus Jachenau, northeast of the church.

## **Approach:** (machine translated)

At the parking lot we take the footbridge over the Kleine Laine and follow the hiking trail (red dot) to the waterfall and further in the direction of Rappinschlucht/Rappinalm. It leads near the Große Laine, first in the forest, up the valley, crosses it after about 40 min. and meets a forest road a little later. Follow this road until you see the Lainlalm in the meadow on the righthand side (up to here see also "Wasserfallweg":

http://www.jachenau.de/wasserfall-weg). Here we turn right off the forest road and follow the footpath, initially in the valley bottom, in a northeasterly direction. When we arrive at the final waterfall of our tour, we march uphill in a few switchbacks, then almost horizontally and relatively close to the stream along the slope. So we finally come to a small concrete bridge. Here we climb in.

#### **Tour:** (machine translated)

Rappels alternate with running routes. Some jumps. Directly at the top of the high final waterfall, at the foot of which mostly bathers cavort, there is a left-hand exit possible jumps. See photos & videos!

### Return: (machine translated)

After the final waterfall turn left onto the footpath and then return to the car on the approach path.
