Alpine forest canyon that only becomes gorge-like towards the exit.

Access: (machine translated)

Coming from Munich we leave the A95 via exit no. 11 - Eschenlohe. We drive into Eschenlohe, meet the Murnauerstraße, turn right here and after a left turn we come to the bridge over the Loisach. After crossing the bridge we follow the Walchenseestraße half-left (direction Walchensee, Wengwies). 1.7 km after the bridge we come to a hikers' parking lot on the right of the road. The road enters the forest here and is closed to vehicles. Here we park our car.

Approach: (machine translated)

We now walk back 270m on the tarred road and then turn left onto a footpath ("Krottenkopf"), which leads us to the footbridge over the Asamklamm gorge. Beyond up the stairs we come to a slope, which we follow to the left ("Krottenkopf via Kuhalm"). We climb steadily uphill on the path. We ignore junctions to the right or to the left. After 3 km the track turns to the south and goes first over the Kessellaine, later over the Pustertalaine. 1.2 km after this striking turn we come to the gulch of the Pustertalaine.

Tour: (machine translated)

To the right of the pipe culvert we descend pathlessly into the streambed, now follow the course of the stream, as far as possible, on the right or left bank (because in the stream terrain slippery). Some unsecured rappels are avoided in this way. Then move along the streambed until you reach the gorge with a total of 4 rappels (max. 15m) at about the beginning of the last quarter. A few meters after the opening of the canyon, we can descend into the Kessellaine coming from the right.

Return: (machine translated)

About 60m down the Kessellaine we see steep trail tracks on the left going up the meadow slope. We follow these if we do not decide to continue the tour through the lower Kessellaine. The path descends towards the Eschenlaine and meets a dirt road, which we follow - after crossing the Eschenlaine in the meantime - to the car (about 3.2 km on the dirt road and subsequent tarred road).
