Small catchment area, discharge is falling faster than Rybi. Should be considered in early summer.

Access: (machine translated)

Idem Rybi Canyon: Cross Lauterbrunnen, 15m after the bridge over the Weisse Lutschine take the road to the left and park at the exit in the parking lot next to the sports field.

Approach: (machine translated)

See the approach to Rybi Canyon. When you cross the Rybi Canyon, follow the path for 200 m to cross the Mättlibach. You can descend to the first obstacle in the RG.

Tour: (machine translated)

The descent begins directly at C130, starting with rappel RD on AN and arriving at the start of a 10 m waterfall in a chute. The relay of the first long length is located behind the chute in RD. From there, a 45m long pitch leads to a niche RD and then on to a 75m long pitch. At the foot of C130 you immediately reach a short and beautiful indentation.

No exit options before the foot of C130, no exit into the mini gulch.

Rappels from the 75m length are a little difficult, a longer rope will make rappels easier if you have a push back. Waterfall clearly visible from the village of Lauterbrunnen.

Return: (machine translated)

Leave RG to reach the old railroad line again, cross the bridge over the Mättli and turn left onto a path immediately after the bridge. Cross the fields in the direction of the parking lot.

Do NOT cross the fields in the middle when the grass is high, so as not to trample the forage, but keep to the edges.
