From Vesio (above Campione del Garda) take the SP 38 to Tignale. This road crosses the Torrente San Michele (Leave a car here if you want to get off at the top of San Michele). With a 180° bend, about 2 km further on, the road crosses the streambed in Valle Tignalga. Parking is possible on the orographic left. 2. park the car at Sermerio near the cemetery. There a road leads downhill.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking lot along the right bank to a water catchment. There descend with the help of ladders, then along the right rock face over gravel (climbing tracks) to the first rappel point.

Tour: (machine translated)

The first rappel not in one go, but rappel to comfortable intermediate level at -30m.\nThe last waterfall at 65m has comfortable entry, but watch out for scouring edge.

Return: (machine translated)

After the Tignalga flows into the San Michele, follow the almost horizontal course of the Michele stream until the first waterfall. On the left side rock wall with iron clamps. Climb up there, then follow the path to Sermerio (1st fork to the left). \nAlternatively, you can also go up the Michele to the road (about 1 h).
