The Yaga River, which rises from the National Park of Monte Perdido, breaks through an impressive aquatic gorge in its lower course before flowing into the Cinca River.

Access: (machine translated)

We drive north on the A-138 from Ainsa in the direction of Bielsa. We come via Labuerda and Escalona to the bridge over the Rio Yaga (17 km from Ainsa, town center), where the Miraval Canyon ends. Here we park the car for the exit. \With the second car we pass the hamlet of Hospital and 450 m after the bridge over the Rio Yaga we turn left uphill at a sharp angle towards Tella, Revilla. Before the first houses of Cortalavina - 3.2 km from the A-138 - we take the dirt road on the left towards Miraval. Continue on this road for about 3.5 km until you come out of the forest into an open space. Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking lot on the path closed to motor vehicles a few hundred meters through the forest to the houses of Miraval and a bridge. Proceed along the left bank of the river to the beginning of the gorge: http://www.wikiloc.com/wikiloc/view.do?id=14717382

Tour: (machine translated)

There are two places that should be our attention: First, a short fixed rope on the right side. Here you should not slide in on the left side, even if the fixed rope is "occupied". This is because you will come up against some twisted rocks and the resulting risk of injury is high. In general, be careful with jumps: The underwater is often blocked or less deep than expected !\n\nThe second place is a narrow chute, which is overcome with spreading or clamping technique.

After the exit of the gorge in a wide gravel bed to the road bridge; get off before it on the left.
