Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful lime canyon in secluded, scenic surroundings; dark grotto at the end of the tour; emergency exit possibility after the first 35m overhang; Good 10m Inox glued anchors/stances, do not forget light for grotto; Well combinable with Grotta Donini (almost the same way back). Mostly stagnant, deep pools with cold water; stream flows into Rio Flumineddu.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) about 1h 20min From Arbatax take the SS125 north (Olbia) to the village of Lozzorei; after the Esso gas station turn left onto the SP56 (Via Milano); follow the road for a long time; at the fork turn right towards Urzulei; follow the main road (SP37) for about 15 km, drive through Urzulei, up the mountain to Urzulei and then turn left onto the SS125 towards Dorgali. Now follow the mountain road until you reach the rock face that can be seen from afar (there is a prominent building on the right) - Turn left here. Follow the asphalt road for about 1 km (under the prominent rock wall around the mountain), then the road becomes an off-road track for 21 km (you are on a plateau) - from here it is about 40 min. (to the parking entry). At the first fork keep right and at the fork with signs (sprayed writing) keep left. After the fork, the road goes down, after two prominent bends, you will cross a crossing (dried streambed). After the crossing, follow the main course of the road through the wooded area (passing a house with a sign "Grotta Donini/Orbisi") for a long time until the exit of the paved road where there is a turnaround area with 2 trees in the middle. Park here (780m).		
Approach: (machine translated) 10min From the car park/turning point, go uphill a little on the right, past the fenced-in property with a striking round building with a wooden roof. Descend here to the Codula Orbisi stream, which you will reach shortly (750m).		

Tour: (machine translated)

Once in the dry streambed, follow the streambed for about 10 minutes without much difference in altitude, until you reach the first abseil point of about 4m (hourglass on the right). Info: On the way to the first descent point you already pass the small entrance hole of Grotta Donini. From here the canyon narrows. There are 2 more rappels in pools before the overhanging 35m rappel. To reach the belay safely, a removable rope traverse should be set up. Here you are often watched by onlooking tourists descending over the ridge into the canyon (possible emergency exit on the left). After a short open walking passages/boulder terrain, there is a step that is downclimbed. Here the canyon narrows again. Then there is a short step, followed by two 20m rappels. Between the rappels you have to climb up from a crevasse using a helpful fixed rope with slings (not so easy). After this point there is a short swimming passage leading into the dark part of the canyon (grotto). In the grotto (darkness) there is a short swimming passage and two abseils of 11m and 17m. Alternatively, according to the topographic view, you can bypass the cave with 2 abseils (12 and 35m). In a short time you have daylight again and you are in front of a large rock hole from which you rappel the last 17m into the open. After this point you can get out at about 540m on the left over the steep rocks (you save the last rather unspectacular steps and ascent time). A little tip: if you first climb up the rocks on the right and then climb down, you will reach the exit/final waterfall of Grotta Donini.

Return: (machine translated)

About 30min

From the point of 540m left over steep, well climbable rock (marking cairn) up. Here the gravel field reached after a short time right, slightly uphill (cairn) until the open ridge follow. Then continue to follow the ridge and the now increasingly visible path uphill. After about 20min you reach the gravel road that you follow past a fountain / watering hole to the starting point / parking lot.
