Summary: (machine translated)

Beautiful and mostly very aquatic lime canyon; cold water; very susceptible to flooding; short abseils (jumps); Inox single hooks (2021); well combinable with Zinkenbach; The combination with the Gerbachcanyoningtour (2x40m ropes/4-5h!!!) which flows into the Ackersbach at the bridge I would recommend only extremely sporty canyoneers; exposure south; most beautiful light incidence from midday; no or poor cell phone reception; in spring a lot of melt water; large catchment area.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

approx. 30min

From Salzburg south via the A10 to the exit Golling. Then continue on the B102 (Lammertalstraße) in the direction of Abtenau. At "Voglauerhof" turn left over the Lammer bridge and then immediately left again. Follow the mountain road to the large parking lot at Pichl (47°36'03,00 N, 13°17'55,00 E) where you park your car.

Approach: (machine translated)

approx. 25-30min bike

Then you ride your bike (next to the Ackersbach) on the wide forest road for about 30min (5.9km) in the direction of Postalm to the bridge that leads over the Ackersbachklamm (758m, WGS84, 47°32`52 "N, 13°20`32 "E). The entry is just after the bridge on the left across the Gerbach tributary which flows into the Ackersbach here.

Tour: (machine translated)

approx. 1h

The Ackersbachklamm is a beautiful, short and mostly very aquatic lime canyon with very clean water. When the water level is high, the canyon should not be underestimated since almost all rappel are in the water course. Some deep pools can also be jumped after checking. The emergency drill set should not be missing, as in the nearby Zinkenbach and Gerbach, also in this remote and rarely visited canyon. On very sunny days, you could also have a wonderful swim/barbecue at the exit).

Return: (machine translated)

approx. 15min foot + 15min bike

After the last two pools, either orogr.r. short, steep and pathless through the dense young forest (near the stream) up to the forest road/bike or follow the stream to a flat forest road(orogr.r.) which leads after a few minutes to the access forest road. Then right again up to the bike.
