Summary: (machine translated) Open and friendly rappel canyon that has its high points towards the exit. First a clarification here. Our canyon, i.e. our stream, flows into a river called the Neda. That's why the waterfalls to the Neda were called "Neda Waterfalls". In order to create conceptual clarity, our stream must therefore be given a name other than Neda. The name Neda becomes even more misleading when you realize that the river into which our stream flows is also used for canyoning.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) If you drive from the coast - Tholo - on the 1410 to the Temple of Apollo of Vasses, you will first come to Neo Figalia, then to Petrolana and finally to Perivolia. Approach: (machine translated) We take the dirt road leading northwards. Where it loses itself, we see a cairn on the righthand side, which leads us up to the right. After a while we come to a generally dry streambed, which we climb down to the entry point into the stream.		
Tour: (machine translated) First many smaller steps with beautiful pools, small slides and possible jumps. Then we come to the 36m waterfall. Tourists can be seen bathing at its foot. This is followed by a smaller waterfall and finally the rappel into the river Neda (from the tree -2023). Here you can admire the gate to the underworld, behind which the Neda disappears (at around 200m),		
Return: (machine translated) A few meters upstream, a fixed rope traverse leads back up to the footbridge below the penultimate waterfall. From here we take the path to the south, take a look at the beautiful arched bridge and then hike up the road to the car.
