Summary: (machine translated) Very beautiful and varied canyon; the upper part is mostly dry; in the lower part the canyon becomes more incised and watery; some downclimbing and jumping spots; two exits on the left side; SW exposure; scenic access above the old town of Kotor with a view of the bay; well-equipped inox stands; watch out for sand vipers/European horned vipers; tributary after first third; in high summer mostly dry.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) approx. 15min From Tivat you drive south. At the big traffic circle (after the airport) turn left towards Kotor. In Kotor drive straight on at the small traffic circle until you reach the bridge. Immediately after the bridge, turn right to the pay parking lot (approx. €1/hour).		
Approach: (machine translated) approx. 2h/1h15min Once you have parked at the paid parking lot in front of the school sports field, follow the path past the school in the direction of the already visible canyon. After crossing the first bridge there is a hiking sign "Planinarska transverzala Orjen-Lovćen-Rumija". Passing the pump house and stone bridge, follow the beautiful hiking trail in several serpentine up to a stone house at about 220m. At the following serpentine bend with markings, you could choose the path visible on the ridge for the lower entry. For this, the main path is left here in the direction of the power pylons. If you want to enter further up, follow the main path further up. (small tip: at approx. 400m shortly before a rusty power pole there is a small fork with an H2O inscription on the left side of the path. Here you can get drinking water after about 20m in the small stone wall tunnel). After the last serpentine you have a wonderful view of the bay of Kotor and the surrounding mountains. From here on it becomes flatter. First you follow the signs "Krstac" and "Lovćen". At the next fork, turn left through the forest until you reach the wall from the KuK period and the entry at the stream at about 580m.		
Tour: (machine translated) about 4,5h/3,5h The Škurda has over 30 rappelling points, whereby the first third (approx. 1h) is mostly waterless. In this part there is also the highest rappelling point of 40m. At the beginning there are 3 nice rappelling points and a long downclimb. After a small cascade, the canyon becomes more incised and continuous. Here comes a tributary from the right into the canyon that brings the most water. Several rappels (max. 35m) follow without much distance until you reach the cut beautiful lower gorge section (Attention! after the 35m +10m rappel you have an entry/exit marked with "EXIT" on the rock on the left side). To the last abseil point of about 20m a removable rope traverse can be set up. After that, the last meters of the canyon are downclimbed/descended to the exit of about 10m.		

Return: (machine translated)

About 10min

You leave the canyon on the right side for about 10m and immediately after the pump station you reach the road/fee parking.

Taxi, cable car and walk down was an acceptable solution for getting back to the start.

We hiked the canyon from the very top, which is worthwhile if you are doing the Skurda for the first time. The hike up is also very beautiful, very hot in summer, so start early and take plenty of water with you. The beginning was dry, we needed about 30 minutes for the downclimb, but you have a beautiful view. After that, there was always little water flowing down to the bottom. The canyon becomes more and more beautiful and we liked it very much. You can check the water level at the exit of the canyon when you walk to the last pool/rappel (10 min.). (machine translated)

Automatisch importiert von Descente-Canyon.com für Canyon Skurda Approach via Kotor fortress wall (dont miss the gate Spiljarskia at 215m., connect with the little bar for coffee, grappa, goat cheese and/or hard boiled egg), start optional at 580m with clear running water in Spring, but all in all less water than last year. Free parking a bit further in the city, in low-season. 80% glue-in bolts. Watch out for non-certified quicklinks and ropes on the anchors and presence of vipers on the approach.
