How to get to Canaletes: We leave the AP-7 - Autopista del Mediteráneo, Tarragona to Valencia - just before reaching the Ebro and we take the C-12 northward to Tortosa (not quite 20 km to the city center). In the town we continue on the C-12 northwards in the direction of Lleida About 3 km after the town of Xerta (and 14.5 km after Tortosa - center) we turn left on the N-230b in the direction of Gandesa. After another 7.2 km we turn left again onto the T-333 towards Valderrobres. Not quite 14 km after the last turnoff, we come to a T-junction, where the T-334 turns off to the right in a northerly direction towards Horta de Sant Joan.\n However, we continue on the T-333 for another 270 m, and then turn left onto the road that heads south towards the mountains. But already 270 m further on we turn left onto a dirt road in the direction of El Ventador Signpost: "Salt de Sotorres et El Ventador". The road leads into the valley of the Riu de Canaleta and up the other side of the hill. 2.2 km after the bridge (and 4.1 km from T-333) - we ignore two dirt roads on the left - we come to the ford through the Cubars.
