Summary: (machine translated) Short, beautiful deeply cut lime canyon; slide brake at the entry; clean water; several slippery spots; often only sparsely penetrating sunlight; nice picnic area at the exit; the canyon is located in the Bellunese Dolomites National Park, where canyoning is officially not allowed; small tip: campsite+pizzeria "Sarathei" at Lago di Santa Croce (approx. 40min. distance) (www.sarathei.it).		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) about 10min From Longarone		
Approach: (machine translated) about 10min from the wooden sign/ 15min from the picnic area Before the tour, the water level should be checked at the last waterfall near the picnic area (effort 5min.). One follows the mountain road with the Val Tovanella wooden sign on the orographic right side of the gorge. Further up, one crosses the stream over a concrete bridge with a view into the canyon. Then you cross 2 more wooden bridges before coming to a suitable place (broken wooden railing). Here you enter the creek in front of the already sighted iron bedload barrier. Entry at about 570m.		
Tour: (machine translated) approx. 1,5h After the slip through at the boulder barrier you follow a still open canyon with small downclimb and abseil sections up to about 5m. The canyon narrows as you progress. Artificial light is usually not necessary, but some parts are very dark and exciting if you don't know the canyon yet. From the middle on the canyon becomes really interesting. After a small jump into a dark pool, you come to a rope traverse with a belaystation on the right side, from which you rappel about 15m into a small grotto. A short narrow walking passage follows before you reach the railroad bridge. (Here, with a lot of skill, you could reach/use the railroad bridge ladder for an emergency exit). The next 20m rappel is completed partly in the water flow and the rope retrieval takes place in the pool. Afterwards, there is a small 2m step (left) that leads to the last 12m waterfall. Here the canyon opens again. The depth of the pool varies, so a jump should be well considered!!! After the last rappel at about 500m the canyon ends.		
Return: (machine translated) approx. 10-15min After the last pool, follow the shallow streambed to the gravel bank in front of the road bridge. Get off here on the left to the picnic parking area or back to the parking area on the access path.
