<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Hiking and rappel canyon as an interesting "feeder" to Bc. de la Fou.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We leave the AP-7 (Autopista de la Mediterrania) on the way from Tarragona towards Valencia about 23 km after crossing the Ebro river at exit 43 - Vinaròs. After leaving the freeway, we take the N-238 towards Vinaròs for about 2 km, but then we turn right and take the CV-11 towards La Senia. We pass El Castel and arrive at La Senia (about 18.8 km from the freeway exit). From La Senia we continue on the CV-105 to the Pantà de Ulldesona reservoir (about 7.5 km from the center of La Senia). We cross an arm of the reservoir and immediately after the bridge we turn right onto a dust road. First we go along the reservoir, then we cross the river to its eastern bank and we stay on the right at the next fork. We continue on the main path along the Barranc de la Fou until we reach a parking area for hikers with information panels on the banks of the stream (10.3 km from the bridge over the reservoir). <b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) At the parking lot, a sign directs us to the Cova dels Bous. Passing the entrance to the cave on the right, we walk slowly upward, gaining altitude, with a view of the valley of the Barranc de la Fou below on the right. We meet an overgrown forest road and follow it until we reach a meadow with "our" stream.
