Watery rappel canyon, side tributary to Saklikent canyon.

Hydrology:

Der Bozudere führt im Frühjahr meist ordentlich Wasser. Trotzdem kann es vorkommen, dass im unteren Abschnitt von heute auf morgen der Wasserdurchsatz fehlt. Grund dürfte eine phasenweise, aber nicht ersichtliche, Versickerung uU. in eine Höhle sein.

Access: (machine translated)

First head for the canyon exit of the Saklikent canyon. Park the car here for the exit. Unless you want to pay a parking fee, park the car south of the river.\nFrom here now drive the road north with the second car. After 2.7 km turn right and drive uphill towards Arsaköy. After 6.1 km uphill we meet a road coming from the north and continue on it to the right in a southerly direction. After another 3.6 km we leave the road to Arkasöy and turn half-right (GPS: 36°30'24.75 "N 29°26'25.56 "E). We follow this road in southwestern direction. After about 1.8 km we come to a T-junction (GPS: 36°29'43.72 "N 29°25'47.79 "E) and turn right here. After 100 m the road turns to the left, 270 m further on the road makes a left turn - straight ahead a side road leads, on the righthand side an elongated hall - and 570 m further on (GPS: 36°29'19.59 "N 29°25'56.43 "E - covered bus shelter) we turn halfright. We now continue another 570 m slightly downhill. Here - GPS: 36°29'7.36 "N 29°25'59.65 "E - we turn left at a right angle onto a dirt road. After 620 m the track crosses "our" brook. We now continue above the stream in a southwesterly direction. After 440 m (from the bridge) we stay right at a fork (near the brook). Again 820 m further on we see a well on the left hand side of the path. Here (GPS: 36°28'46.59 "N 29°25'42.35 "E) we park the car for an integral ascent. Access here as described for Monster Canyon Superior.\nlf we want to enter the lower part directly, we continue on the dirt road and after about 900 m we meet a dirt road coming down from the left. Now descend on this to the right, as far as passability is given. We drove about 900 m further and then parked the car (GPS: 36°28'15.71 "N 29°25'7.85 "E). \n

Approach: (machine translated)

From the latter parking lot we walk across the meadows in southwestern direction towards the edge of the slope (GPS: 36°28'15.23 "N 29°24'59.90 "E) Here we look for a track leading down to the saddle between Saklikent canyon (left) and Monster canyon (right). From the saddle we follow the trail that leads us down in northwestern direction to Monster Canyon (entry). \n

Tour: (machine translated)

For lack of own ascent here only a few clues. At the beginning, the gradient should not be too steep, so that walking, downclimbing and smaller rappel up to about 20m are to be expected. However, the canyon then drops steeply down to the bottom of Saklikent canyons. Here, several rappels in the order of over 40m are likely to be called for. The last rappel can be seen in one of the photos.

Return: (machine translated)

Once in Saklikent Gorge, walk downstream, then cross the tributary from the karst spring (can be difficult if there is enough water and without the rope usually stretched here in season) and then walk out on the footbridge above the river to the parking lot.
