From Tolmezzo go north until Zuglio. In Zuglio go up the hill towards Fiedelis. Parking is possible just after the town sign where a sand road branches off to the left.

**Approach:** (machine translated) Follow the sand road to the creek.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

10 rappels, slides and jumps with lots of walking terrain. The canyon is equipped with 6mm Multimunti screw hooks and thin chain links. \nIn the middle of the canyon a hiking trail crosses the stream, here break off the tour possible.

Bypass the last art steps on the right bank.
