Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful, vegetated, slippery canyon with 3-person cascade at the end (75m); when there is a lot of water, the canyon becomes dangerous; stances are well established; emergency exit possible before the last 4 rappel left.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) approx. 10min From Bovec drive in the direction of Kobarid --> park in the village of Zaga before the bridge on the left side of the road in a turnout.		
Approach: (machine translated) approx. 1h From the parking lot to the inn --> behind the inn a road goes up --> follow this for a few meters until a path branches off to the left --> follow this path parallel to the Ujcia --> there are several branches where you always keep to the left --> after a while you reach a meadow with a hut and a well --> behind this hut continue up the not always clearly visible path (parallel to the canyon) --> at about 700Hm you reach the stream.		
Tour: (machine translated) approx. 3h It starts immediately with an approx. 25m rappel --> further short to medium high rappels follow --> walking passages --> until one comes to a 40m rappel with a sharp edge! (before that there is an emergency exit) --> after the high rappel again some medium high rappels follow --> after an approx. 10m rappel comes a short walking passages where you can get out over the visible hiking trail --> short rappel left of the tree --> now it really vertically further --> in a 3-person cascade it goes down a total of about 75m (C20, C30, C20) --> the pools are not so big --> belay to stand recommended!		
Return: (machine translated) approx. 30min After the last rappel left follow the trail to the meadow with hut and fountain --> follow the trail further to the parking lot.
