Summary: (machine translated) Shale rock; some nice pools; some jumps; several downclimb and walking passages; clean water; water level can change quickly; mostly aquatic even in summer; highest (57m) rappel can be partially downclimbed. Exposure: west - best time to climb in the afternoon		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) about 1h from Arbatax + 20min transfer From Arbatax on the SS125 towards the south (Cagliari); After several kilometers turn right towards "Bari Sardo" continue on the SS125; After another kilometers at the fork keep right towards Cardedu on the SS125; 3km after Cardedu there is a prominent arched bridge where you turn right onto the SP28 towards Gairo S. Elena and drive up. Follow the road until Gairo, through Gairo until the stop sign. Continue left on the SS198 downhill, over a bridge and briefly uphill towards Seui. Here, in the hairpin bend with km stone II 73, leave the main road to the right onto the concrete road. The concrete road soon becomes a gravel road, which you follow for 1.5km. Here you can park the transfer vehicle in the bulge before or after the forest road that leads down to the right. With the 2nd car you go back to the village of Gairo. Pass the gas station in the direction of Sarcerei. After the village exit (Gairo) follow the mountain road for 2.8km. On the left side of the road you will see a small gravel road leading down to the stream. Right next to the brook you can park.		
Approach: (machine translated) 0 min. Enter the stream directly from the parking lot at 820m.		
Tour: (machine translated) 2h Riu Sarcerei is a varied, beautiful but discontinuous shale gorge with mostly short rappels. The short rappels are almost all in water flow and should not be underestimated at higher water levels. The highest rappel of 55m goes over a sloping rock slab that can be partially downclimbed, so 60m ropes are not essential (assuming skillful downclimbing). Several steps can be bypassed or downclimbed and some pools invite you to jump. Towards the exit of the tour the canyon becomes more incised. Here you also have the most possible jumps. After the narrower part, the canyon opens, here the last 200m or so can be walked along a path next to the stream. The Riu Sarcerei flows into the Riu Pardu here is also the exit at 550m.
