Rappel canyon, dry; upper part not very rewarding, but final passage impressive.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From Barbastro in the direction of Alquézar. After about 20 km on the newly expanded A-1232 up to Alquezar. There we park our car in the parking lot above the center.

Approach: (machine translated)

You can start directly from Alquezar on a track, cf.: http://www.wikiloc.com/wikiloc/view.do?id=10481776\nBut it seems more favorable to drive first from Alquezar or Radiquero by car to San Pelegrin (from the first parking lot in Alquezar left away 2.6 km), to cross the village and then to drive another 1.9 km further north. Here, at an acute angle, a dirt road turns off to the right and we leave our car here.

Here begins a path that leads uphill in a northerly direction (a small right-left turn in between). Later it turns a bit in direction NNO.

We come to the ridge and go there about 80 m to SSo to meet a path coming from the south. We now follow it to the left. The path bends to the left and joins a path coming from the right. On the now common path we go north for about 150 m, then we turn right on a path that brings us after about 500 m to a right side stream of the Chimiachas. From here, head in a northeasterly direction to the Chimiachas.

If you only want to rappel the interesting lower part, you can get there directly from Tozal dero Tiesto on a well-kept path (the thinly dotted path in the overview map down to Rio Vero).

Tour: (machine translated)

9 rappel; the upper part up to the intersection with the path wins only by the view. However, the long final rappels, especially the last one into the "Cocineta" can impress.

Return: (machine translated)

3 possibilities. Either in the Rio Vero to the Puente Villacantal and from here to Alquezar or in the BVero downstream to pull up right at the height of the large overhang (tracks, cairns).

A third option would be to wade upstream the Vero for about 150 m and then take the path that I already mentioned as an access route to the intermediate entry from above.

The trail we took goes up from the river first on a rock ramp, then crosses a small wall above the Chimiachas (wire rope), then crosses the Chimiaachas itself and goes up to the high ground. There, either turn left to Alquezar or, after a short stretch of this path, turn right onto the dirt road that leads to the car north of San Pelegrin.
