Summary:

U-shaped mini-canyon with 7 abseils and good flow throughout the year. Only interesting as collector's canyon when you've done the nearby Nucci, Susanna, Ciorosolin, Stuet, Pes, Meda, Spessa...

Hydrology:

Park the car (or bike) at Gobo bridge.

Approach:

Just before Gobo bridge leaves a trail on our right (river left) which crosses the scree at first (don't climb up before having crossed the scree), then climbs faint, nearly inexistant through grass and by the end some bushes or trees, descend the side river to the confluence and start of the canyon.

Tour:

Surprisingly well bolted, mostly M10 and doubled, AIC mentions 35m max but this is the total waterfall. Mid-way there is a mid-belaystation, which is more like 25m.
