Summary: (machine translated) Rappel in a cathedral of nature		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) There is an access and entry possibility from the north (Beceite) and one from the east (Tortosa). The latter will be described here. We leave the AP-7 - Autopista del Mediterráneo, Tarragona to Valencia - just before reaching the Ebro and take the C-12 northward to Tortosa (not quite 20 km to the town center). In the town we continue on the C-12 north towards Lleida. At the big square "Plaça de la Corona d'Aragó" - before reaching the shopping center on the right side - we turn left into Av. Ports Tortosa-Beseit First we pass Roquetes, then we take the Cami de Caro in many serpentines up to the high valley at the foot of Monte Caro - 19,6 km from Tortosa. As the road branches here, we do not take the road to the left up to Monte Caro, but keep to the right. This road - later it mutates into a dirt road - we now drive 5.7 km in southwestern direction downhill. At this point a dirt road branches off to the right at a right angle. It is normally closed for motor vehicles (barrier), but seems to be passable by motor vehicles in the period from Oct. 15 to Dec. 1. Cf: http://uecbarrancs.blogspot.de/2008/10/regatxol.html This would make the access described below from here unnecessary. So we park our car here if we do not arrive here during the period in question.		
Approach: (machine translated) We now walk/ride as this slope, always following the "main trail", first roughly horizontally in the basic direction north, then downhill in a westerly direction. At the double serpentine, on the righthand side in the streambed, we find Salt de Cabrit (25 m), which is secured and can be approached from the slope. Continuing on the slope, we can see the Ragatxol disappear between the rocks on the right (4.3 km from the junction). Here we climb into the streambed and go forward until the narrowing. Tour: (machine translated) First some Gumpenhüpfer, then he big rappel in the Kethedrale. Depending on the water level, the rappel height here can vary between 45m and 55m. Then some more walking and some rubber, then we are sch at the exit of the tour.

At the cairn, take the path on the left up to the slope and on it left to the car. Cf.: \n *
