Parking exit: From Tolmezzo in the direction of Verzegnis, after crossing the Tagliamento river parking possibility near a bunker. \Entrance: Take the road up to Chiaulis - cross the bridge and park about 300m after at a picnic area.

Unfortunately, very polluted water by the village above, if then go only immediately after very heavy rains.\n \nThe gorge is about to narrow - walk along the concrete socket of a water pipe until you can reach the first fuse on the opposite wall. In the first gorge some swimming passages in very dirty water, then a long stretch of walking in an open valley before the canyon narrows again. A few slippery downclimbs and a 22m waterfall (anchor on the right) follow, then another 3m jump before reaching the bridge at the climbing garden. Here climb up to the road or descend even further (slippery downclimb and 1x20m rappel).
