**Access:** (machine translated)

Follow road 209 to the houses of Nomenj. In the area of Nomenj, turn left onto a dirt road that immediately passes through a culvert under the railroad. After the culvert, follow the dirt road to the right until you reach a parking lot in front of a bridge built in 2011. Popular bathing place.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Lower part: Cross the Sava River and follow it upstream until you reach the waterfall at the gorge exit. 50m west and east of the gorge exit, climbs begin that lead to a small bridge above the last gorge. Continue to follow the clear climbing tracks uphill until you can descend to the stream below a rockfall. Upper part: cross the Sava River and follow the trail upstream to the exit of the sand road. From here, follow the tracks south uphill (dry stream valley) until you reach a forest road. Follow this until you can descend through the forest to the stream after a wood storage area. If you have two cars at your disposal, you can get from the upper parking lot to the upper entry as follows. At the first forest road junction turn left, then right onto an overgrown forest road, which you follow until you reach the stream in the area of the karst spring.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

You reach the stream in the area of a strong karst spring. After a short, low gorge follows a long, slippery walking passages before the stream flows into a low gorge. Jumps up to 12m and rappel up to 15m alternate. Very nice washed out rock with rock gates and arches. Beware of siphons and deep scours hidden in the white water. After a large rockfall from the right side of the valley, the stream can be left (access path for the lower part) The rappels in the lower part are placed a bit more exposed and are mostly reached via traverses. The gorge ends with a beautiful 9m jump into a large pool. Commercially used In dry summers, the Grmecica can dry up completely.

Are east of the canyon according to the description up the path. But a lot has changed in recent years. There is a new cycle path down by the Sava. The path up the mountain is extremely overgrown. We went up the slope without a path, between bushes and thorns, which wasn't much fun. Then over the Mala Recevnica hilltop and an old overgrown tractor path southwest into the canyon. Maybe 300m below the spring. The upper part of the canyon is very slippery and partly very blocked with wood. A chain is very questionable, the chain links are very worn in by the movement of the flood. But still a great area. The lower part, which is also used commercially, is superiore. Deep pools, well built, only one place with a lot of wood. The final waterfall was also a great jump. (machine translated)
