<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Rappel canyon that rarely has water. Slippery terrain.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Barbastro on the N-123, 17.5 km in the direction of Benabarre, Graus. In a parking bay on the left before a tunnel in the narrows (Congosto) of the Rio Èsera park car.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the car about 750 m back on the road (downstream) to a prominent road widening. Here we take the wide hiking trail (GR, red-white marking), which leads us in about 15 min. up to a striking rock formation (to the left - possibly occupied by vultures). Here we leave the GR that goes up to the right and continue straight ahead at about the same altitude (sometimes sloping a bit) for about 30 min. until we reach the clearly visible edge of "our" barranco. While the path now descends into it, we keep on indistinct climbing tracks on its origraf. left edge upwards and thus come to the clearly recognizable entry.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) 12 rappel, emergency exit left on the run after the 5th rappel		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) The exit can be difficult. When the Rio Èsera has low water (the rule below a barrage), one crosses the road and the water pipe in a tunnel and then the river to the other bank. There, about 260 m upstream; below the bottleneck, you cross back over the Èsera, climb up to the road and come downstream to the car. However, when the Èsera is in flood (e.g. after heavy rains or in times of snowmelt) this way back is blocked. Then you have to fight your way up the 250 m to the exit on the road (so we did) or downstream for about 300 m to a steep cirque at the level of an old pillar ("piliar"), where you should get up to the road (as described at descent-canyon.com). Since about 2018, you are spared this alternative, because at the end of the canyon to the right up an exit directly to the road is established.
