<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Rappel canyon, mostly without water flow. Has also been called the most beautiful canyon in Catalonia.

<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Coming from the north (Andorra, Seu d'Urgell) or south (Lleida) respectively on the C 14, turn at Coll de Nargo on the L 511 towards Tremp. After 16.2 km, we take the road that branches off to the left towards Gavarra. We continue in a southerly direction and about 300 m before reaching the village and before the road rises again, we come to a road junction around which several farmsteads are grouped. Here we take the road in an easterly direction, always keeping to the right at junctions, the road curves to the south and after 4.4 km we come to a barn on the left side of the road. To the left we look at a larger open space. To the right of the track, which describes a slight left bend in front of the barn, is a flat area to the right of the track. Here we park our car.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the car we descend the slope in a westerly direction to the streambed (entry).		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) The canyon, which is extremely attractive when water is flowing through it, is not to be underestimated in its length and because of the danger of falling rocks (especially when it rains); in addition, when water is flowing through it, the Rio Rialb, into which the canyon flows and which must be followed a good way down, can also flood (probably still doable up to a point).		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After reaching the Riu Rialb, we wade downstream until the canyon opens. Here we then see a vegetated boulder in the riverbed. Here we then also see markings on the left bank indicating the exit. We climb up and meet a forest path. We follow this to the left, keeping close to the canyon rim if in doubt, and return to the car.
