Summary: (machine translated) Short but impressive canyon.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Coming from Oloron-Sainte-Marie, we drive 30.5 km in a southerly direction on the N-134 direction Spain (Col de Somport, Jaca). Then we turn right onto the D-239 to Lescun. We drive uphill in serpentines and park our car 3.8 km after turning off the N-134 on the right-hand side of the road.		
Approach: (machine translated) We walk across the meadow below the road down to the river without a path. The literature now recommends access from the other side of the slope.		
Tour: (machine translated) First in the streambed, then we pass a siphon on the left, now stand in a large vault and take the next rappel (38m) in the left chute. There is a lot of spray below the fall, so the rope retrieval should work. The following 2m step is usually jumpable.		
Return: (machine translated) As soon as possible, turn right uphill and in an arc to the bridge - Pont de la Cascade. From here, head northwest back up to the road.
