From Chambery, take the D 11 up to Curienne and on to Boyat. Here, take the D 201 towards Puygros. Descend through the forest to the Ternéze stream. Dann weiter gem.

#### **Approach:** (machine translated)

We take the path that leads downhill in a north-westerly direction. We come to a shoulder in the terrain and descend here to the left in the hollow without a path down to the stream. We follow it and come to the entrance at a dilapidated wall arch (see link to the ascent, descent and return route).

# Tour: (machine translated)

First downhill over large boulders. The key section starts on the right-hand edge and opens up several variations. 50m further on, the attractive part comes to an exit. We continue walking along the streambed until the Ternèze flows into the Leysse.

### Return: (machine translated)

Here we cross to the other bank and take the path that takes us up the Leysse to a larger hiking trail. Turn right here, over the footbridge and up onto the shoulder, where we meet up with our approach path again.
