Summary: (machine translated) Rappel canyon, dry		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We start in Valderrobres on the bridge over the Río Matarraña. First we drive west on the A-231 for about 500 m in the direction of Horta de San Joan, then we turn off at the large traffic circle onto the A-2412 and now drive south. After 6.2 km we arrive at Beceite. Here we follow the signs "La Pesquera" or the Camino of the same name and arrive on a dirt road in the valley of the Río Ulldemó. After 3.1 km (from the center of Beceite) we arrive directly at the river at the signpost "PR-TE 151 Peñagalera" to a small parking bay, where we park our car.		
Approach: (machine translated) We follow the trail signs through the river to the northern bank and follow the well-marked trail uphill. We come to a first saddle after about 50 min. We cross a rock bar and come to another saddle. We continue to follow the yellow-white or yellow markings. We now walk along the orographic right edge of a wide hollow. At a suitable point we descend on sight into this barranco. Cf.: * http://www.wikiloc.com/wikiloc/view.do?id=11363047		
Tour: (machine translated) We come to the first 3 rappel, then from the left comes a side barranco. Now it goes gumpenweise downhill to the succession of the next rappel, now already in the narrowly cut barranco. This is followed by a run in the now again open canyon, some more rappels and then the highlight. In the huge cauldron below us, we first rappel 12 m to a belaystation in the vertical on a ledge. This is followed by the 45 m rappel in the "Gran Circo". After 2 more rappels we are at the bottom.		
Return: (machine translated) We walk downstream, enter the streambed of the Río Ulldemó and walk in it until we reach the car.
