how to Cl. inferiore: Coming from Turin, Frejus we leave the A32 by the exit "Susa Est", cross the town of Susa and then take the SP210 to Novalesa. Once there, without crossing the Rio Claretto, we take "Via Roma" in a southeasterly direction to Sant'Anna. Soon after the last houses of Novalesa we come to the bridge over the Rio Marderello. Just before the bridge we park our car on the left.\n\nlf we are coming from the direction of Briancon, we leave the A32 at the exit "Susa Ovest" and get directly onto the SP210, which leads us to Novalesa (see aerial photos for the approach).

Approach: (machine translated)

First as for the Cl. inferiore: we take the path that leads from the car towards the final waterfall of the Claretto, clearly visible. We come to the stream, cross it and climb steeply on a path on the orographic right bank. We come across a forest path, follow it and then, on the right, a little below, we see the small diversion channel and come to an alpine hut ("La mojùn de paréin Steu"). Here would be the access to Cl. inferiore \n\nBut we continue to go up on the slope until a leftward haipin bend at 1520m altitude. Here we can shorten two serpentines that extend far to the north (see access in the photo gallery). At the leftward haipin bend at 1520m we then turn right off the road and take the trail down to the creek (entry).\n\n

Tour: (machine translated)

About 32-34 rappel only in the upper part. Arrived at the bridge where the entry to the lower part is made, we can either exit to the right and go back and down the access path or, if conditions are suitable, we decide to continue the descent in the lower part (see - also for the way back in this case - description Cl. inf.).
