From the parking lot, walk briefly across the stream and parallel to the watercourse across the meadow. After 5 minutes it becomes rockier and you automatically want to get to the canyon.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

The first pools look jumpable. Then a higher rappel soon follows. Tourists are often encountered at the foot of the rappel. Unfortunately, anchors have been stolen here, so you have to follow the path downwards. Then you walk along the stream on path tracks and after a few minutes it becomes rockier again and the second part begins. There are some nice pools here too, until the 80 m final waterfall provides a beautiful finale.

**Return:** (machine translated)

Follow the stream over many rock slabs and a few easy climbs. After about 20 minutes, you will see a path on the left that gains some height until it flattens out and soon joins the road.
