From the road that connects Split, Omiš and Makarska along the coast, turn off towards Zadvarje after Omiš. Before the town sign, turn left and take a small road. After the power station, turn right over the bridge to Kostanje and Podgrade. At the first hairpin bend, follow the road on the right that leads through vegetable gardens. Park in the hairpin bend where the road begins to be concreted.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

A path starts at the steel manhole cover and leads to the last lake in 5 minutes.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Go up this huge cauldron and leave it at a right angle (be careful, you are upside down) at a scree slope. Take the path up and continue 20 m further up. From here, admire the hanging pool on the right and especially the huge siphon on the left, which collects all the water from the river, even though it carries a lot of water. The tormented rock offers numerous shapes. From the points, it is possible to install a handrail to take advantage of the balconies that offer jumps from different heights after the usual checks. Caution Avoid descending to the dry spillway for fun. If you slip, you will be crushed in the pool.

Always keep at a right angle, reach the river via the rocks and head upstream. This part of the hike over the boulders can be tiring. Be careful not to slip.

You quickly reach the second point of interest, the Cubavica waterfall. It consists of two parts, a 35 m long first waterfall and a 13 m long second waterfall. The atmosphere is impressive. Once the MC RD is installed, you can climb up to the second pool. Jumps are also possible here after the usual checks.

Access further up is through an RG tunnel, which is difficult to reach. It can be found at the exit of a scree slope that begins 100 m below the Cubavica waterfall. In addition to the darkness, you may encounter accompanied groups, which can make the crossing more difficult. For the way back, go back the way you came.

**Commitment**

Strong. There is no escape.

**Time period/ water character**

Be careful, the flow speed is always enormous. Take a professional with you if you want to walk it without risk. There are no abseiling points in the waterfalls. Everything can be bypassed through tunnels. However, you can take advantage of some of the pools. You can also climb back up from the bottom!

Dangerous water flow! This canyon can only be tackled in an out-and-back route
