Summary: (machine translated) Not very challenging, but quite fun, aquatic canyon that has a bit of everything (jumps, slides, rappel, narrow swimming spots).		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Coming from Scheibbs drive towards Lunz am See, at Weißenbach turn left towards Langau. Approx. 1 km after Langau, you can park on the right at the old forester's lodge (before the bridge).		
Approach: (machine translated) If you want to walk the entire canyon, take the forest road up the southern bank of the canyon. After about 2km you come to a fork, here you take the downhill forest road which crosses a stream after a few hundred meters - this is the entry point. If you only want to do the more interesting lower part, take the marked hiking trail on the northern bank of the canyon. After about 35 minutes of ascent, you cross the 'Gerade Plan', an avalanche gully. Follow the clear climbing tracks into the streambed.		
Tour: (machine translated) There are two small rappels to complete in the side stream before you reach the Taglesbach. After a short section of walking, you soon come to a slide about 7m high, followed by another longer section of walking until you reach the alternative access. Further down, the stream narrows and becomes increasingly aquatic. There are 2-3 rappels (the third one can also be jumped, but is relatively narrow), several small jumps and a few slides.		
Return: (machine translated) Simply get out on the left and take the hiking trail back to the parking lot.
