Résumé: (traduction alternative) The descent is a series of small ledges and slides.		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) In L'Argentière, take the road that leads to the Fournel valley and the silver mines of the same name. Follow the road to the parking lot of the mine, which is the lower parking lot (small wooden hut with telephone booth).		
Approche: (traduction alternative) From the parking lot, follow the asphalt road uphill to the beginning of the canyon (signposted).		
Tour: (traduction alternative) The descent consists of a series of small jumps, slides, etc. During the walk down, there are 3 or 4 passages under blocks or siphons that break up the descent. One of the siphons is remarkable in the middle of the canyon. The blocks form a floor with a siphon in the middle. Despite the feeling of confinement, it goes very well and you end up in the pool below in a fraction of a second. Everything can be done without ropes, without having to worry. The level can change quickly. The canyon has a number of via ferratas, which are equipped like climbing routes and, above all, are well marked. There is also a scale at the entrance indicating the water level. Allowed only if:- uniquement si le niveau est inférieur à 0 sur l'échelle de niveau située à l'entrée du canyon. July to September seems to be the best time for this canyon, which is heavily frequented by tour guides. It is the most frequented canyon in the Haut Val-Durance, as it is one of the easiest and suitable for a first discovery of the area, in a beautiful natural setting. If you know how to use the terrain, it even offers good opportunities for jumps, slides and unexpected passages.
