**Matériel:** Cordes: 2x20m

**Résumé:** (traduction alternative)

Very short but beautiful tour; well combinable with Schwarzenbach near Forchach; emergency exits before and after the highest rappel stage; rock hole at C16; exposure east; very well equipped; commercially climbed; sedimentary rock.

### Hydrologie:

Accès: (traduction alternative)

From Reutte to the village of Stanzach. Immediately after the village turn right towards Vorderhornbach. Follow the country road across the Lech. Immediately after the bridge (approx. 50m) there is a large parking lot on the left. Park here.

## **Approche:** (traduction alternative)

30min

From the parking lot, briefly follow the road back to the bridge and then continue along the bike path downstream to a yellow sign "Moos, Baichlstein". From here, follow the wide forest road slightly uphill jus to a beautiful viewpoint with a wooden bench. Immediately after the bend with the wooden bench, a small path leads down to the streambed on the right. Entry at approx. 1020m.

#### **Tour:** (traduction alternative)

1h

The tour is very short and is commercially used, but it is still worthwhile. After a short walking area, the canyon narrows and the first well secured absells in the water appear. Thanks to fixed ropes and good footholds, most of the steps can be mastered without danger even at higher water levels. If the pools are not covered with gravel, you can also slide down some small steps. The highlight in the middle of the gorge is a 90° left turn with a rock hole. Here is also the highest rappel point (16m) in the water stream (can also be rappelled dry through the rock hole if the water level is high. After the highest rappel point there are three smaller steps with max. 7m before the canyon ends much too fast.

**Retour:** (traduction alternative)

20min

Get off either before or after the bike path bridge and follow the bike path to the right back to the parking lot.
