## **Hydrologie:**

Accès: (traduction alternative)

By car from Salzburg - Bad Reichenhall - continue in the direction of Lofer. Shortly before the border turn off to Melleck. After about 1.5 km, directly along the state border, there is a bridge over the Steinbach. Park here at the parking lot next to it.

#### Approche: (traduction alternative)

Directly at the parking lot walk the Fortsstraße along the Steinbach. After more than a kilometer, a bridge leads over the Vorderer Steinbach. We pass the path to the left (south) to Rosskar and Sonntagshorn and continue on the previous path steeply up the mountain. We also leave the right departing path to the entry into the Vorderen Steinbach unattended and subsequently cross 2 orographic. left side streams of the Hinteren Steinbach. Where on the Austrian topographic view the path makes a sharp bend to the right and away from the streambed, we descend in a southwesterly direction into the streambed.

## Tour: (traduction alternative)

Not particularly attractive forest canyon with some rappel (something for "collectors").

#### **Retour:** (traduction alternative)

After the last rappel a few minutes in the rappel downhill and then at the point where the path to Rosskar and Sonntagshorn crosses the stream, out to the left and on the approach path back to the car.

Good and large parking lot, right next to the stream. Good access throughout, entry clearly recognizable thanks to a relatively new (2021) dark green hunter's stand. Also a pleasant opportunity to change clothes. There is only one turn-off on the access, after the striking bridge, keep right uphill here. The stream is relatively slippery. Some of the protection is difficult to find as there are only single pitons of the older generation. At the exit, stay in the stream, on several ascents I was tempted to climb up to the path on the left, but the path is higher than you think. (traduction alternative)
