Résumé: (traduction alternative)

One of the most beautiful canyons i.d. Pyrenees; magnificent rock formations; should have made every canyoneers times; very grippy limestone; clean water; short rappel; very long walking and climbing passages; for the ascent much to drink with you; leave early; long access; many thorn bushes on the ascent; conditionally demanding; long time no emergency exit; exit before the 2nd part (Garanta Barrasil) li possible.

From the village of Rodellar, campsite Mascun park.

Approche: (traduction alternative)

approx. 2,5-3h

From Rodellar take the footpath to the creek (Mascun) --> follow the creek upstream until the signpost 'Nassare' --> cross the creek to the left --> follow the path --> open area with further signpost 'Nassare' (right) --> long rock face --> follow the path over the plateau to the next signpost --> to the left. Follow the path until after approx. 2h the village (small group of houses) Nassare becomes visible --> pass it on the right --> after the village keep to the left at the fork --> now descend through thorn bushes to the creek (depending on pace another 30min-1h) --> on the left bank follow the creek to the entry.

Tour: (traduction alternative)

approx. 6h

Arrived at the entry you see immediately gigantic large smooth limestone slabs in the stream --> here comes from the right a 2nd tributary --> past the Steinmandl begins one of the most beautiful canyoning tours of the Pyrenees --> it follows in the upper third of countless washed out and smooth with crystal clear water felt pools that jumped, climbed around or. in the upper third the canyon narrows continuously --> here you can't get out of the amazement because you can see so many different shaped rock formations and pools --> in the whole canyon the rock is very grippy --> most of the looking slides are more suitable for jumping or swimming downclimb --> the canyon is wide enough to move around --> at noon nice light --> at the places where a jump is questionable, there is always a downclimb possibility --> several times there are big rock labyrinths which can be climbed around at the top or the the canyon opens up again --> the grandiose scenic with the versatile beautiful places remains until the end --> not to forget that the canyon is very long and without emergency exit, therefore jumps should always be well judged --> once you have left the middle part behind you, the canyon narrows again --> longer walking and swimming sections alternate --> the final section stretches over several 100m --> here you move almost exclusively in open sunny terrain (streambed) --> at the final part of the Gorgas Negras there is a swimming section after which you find yourself on open terrain with a visible path (right.) and high narrow trees --> from here also the following 'Garanta Barrasil' starts --> noticeable is the red rock on the left side --> the Garanta Barrasil is walked by a lot of people --> the canyon is not so long, but also has very nice parts --> in the Garanta Barrasil you don't need a rappel but still enough strength reserves to climb the next approx. 2-3h walking and climbing to overcome --> at the final part of the 2nd canyon comes another approx. 300m long beautiful swimming section --> after a short walking passages (right) you are in front of the stone bridge at the campsite.

Retour: (traduction alternative)

approx. 45min

Way back is via the steep campsite access road up to the road and on to Rodellar (ca. 1,5Km, ca. 45min.)
